MEDICATION PROCEDURE

Please note the regulations regarding Benadryl, Advil, Motrin, Alleve, etc. Please read the following carefully so we may properly tend to your child's needs.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS: Must be brought in by the parent in the original pharmacy bottle with your child's name, the name of the medication, the date it was filled, and the dose and frequency of the medication. Medications can only be given on the written order of the doctor prescribing it.

NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION: The school nurse is permitted to administer Tylenol, antacids, and lozenges with parent's written permission and at the discretion of the nurse. **ALL OTHER MEDICATIONS (INCLUDING BENADRYL, ADVIL, MOTRIN, ALLEVE, EYE DROPS, MEDICATED CREAMS, ETC.) REQUIRE A PHYSICIAN'S SIGNATURE.**

We stock adult and children's strength Tylenol and Benadryl in the health office. You must bring in any other medications for your child. The medications **MUST** be in the original package. We will not give any medications that come in envelopes or baggies.
